
## **Images in Haematology**

A 32 years-old woman with AML-M2 developed fever (38.5°C) on the third day of treatment. No infectious foci was found on physical examination. As she was neutropenic, cefepime + ami-kacin treatment was started. On the fourth day the patient was still febrile. Chest X-ray revealed nonspesific findings. Cefepime was replaced with meropenem. On the seventh day of fever, chest X-ray and serum galactomannan level detected by ELISA was normal. Empirical antifungal treatment was started with conventional amphotericin-B and computed tomography of thorax was performed. Ground glass appearence surrounding a big nodule (halo-sign) was detected. Also a crescent-like air bubble (air-crescent) was seen in the nodule. Fever resolved on the fourth day of antifungal therapy.

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
